PUBLIC HEALTH ADVISORY:

Swimming Allowed at Town Beach

October 2, 2021

Results of water quality samples taken on September 21 and September 30 by the MA Department of Public Health (MDPH) show cyanobacteria levels below the MDPH guideline level of 70,000 cells/ml as well as non-detect readings for cyanotoxins. In addition, water visibility is over 5 feet.

At this time, the Board of Health is *lifting* the No Swimming advisory.
