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### COVID-19 VACCINATION DATA UPDATE December 9, 2021

The Harvard Board of Health and Nashoba Associated Boards of Health are aware of an anomaly in the Town of Harvard vaccination data available on the State Department of Public Health website. Specifically, the data available for Harvard is based on a population of 6,951, while the Town Clerk reports 5,512 residents as of December 2, 2021.

The table below shows the Board's calculation of Harvard's vaccination rate based on the Town Clerk's population numbers.
