**HARVARD CEMETERY DEPARTMENT SCHEDULE**

(Effective March 1, 2017)

Lot Size	Lot Cost	Internments	Cost
Single Grave	\$850.00	Casket Burials (Tuesday through Friday)	\$825.00
Two Graves	\$1,700.00	Cremations (Tuesday through Friday)	\$600.00

Arrangements must be made with a Cemetery Commissioner PRIOR TO INTERNMENT.

Each grave site may contain ONE casket and THREE cremation internments. If the FIRST Internment in a grave site is a CREMATION internment, then NO casket internment may be made in the Lot.

Friday Placements after 11:00 A.M. and Saturday Placements must be arranged for with the Cemetery Commissioners. Overtime charges will apply; bringing the Internment costs to: Caskets \$950.00 and Cremations \$650.00. Saturday Internments after 1:00 P.M. are dependent upon available personnel and will have an additional up charge of minimum \$400.00 to cover incurred labor costs. NO SUNDAY OR MONDAY INTERNMENTS!!

Cemetery Lots CAN NOT be sub-divided.

**MONUMENTS AND MARKERS**

Permission of the Cemetery Commission must be obtained before any monuments or markers may be installed on a Lot.

One one (1) upright monument (Lot stone) is permitted on a Lot, regardless of Lot size. Individual flush with ground FOOT STONES are permitted.

Lot monuments and cement bases, which are required for them, are to be installed by Professional monument companies, arrangement for which must be made by Lot owner.

A flat marker, flush with the ground, which also requires a cement base, may be installed by a Professional monument company, or by the Harvard Cemetery Department for a fee of \$100.00. There is no fee for Installation of Government supplied Veterans Markers.

### **LOT CORNER MARKERS**

Installation of personalized or initialed Lot corner markers, for better identification of Lot bounds, is encouraged, with Cemetery Commission approval.

### **PLANTINGS AND GRAVE DECORATIONS**

NO perennial type plantings are allowed WITHOUT the permission of the Cemetery Commission. Gifts or perennial plantings such as shrubs or trees in memory of loved ones, with the approval of the Cemetery Commission, would be welcomed.

*NOT ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS, PLANTS OR DECORATIONS ARE PERMITTED IN THE CEMETERY.*

### **PAYMENTS TO THE CEMETERY DEPARTMENT**

Checks in payment of cemetery fees should be made payable to the Town of Harvard and should be directed to the Harvard Cemetery Department, Town Hall, and 13 Ayer Road, Harvard, MA 01451.

### **SIZE OF MARKERS**

3-ft. height by 4-ft. width with 2 ft. base from front to back.
