- Expense report prepared and shared by Nick

Tyler's independent study, the organ project, is going so far/so good — Brittany is his advisor and she has been in contact with his Bromfield facilitator. The committee would like to have more students take advantage of independent projects through HCTV in time.

Sound proof booth construction at the studio has been looked into by Rob. Building inspector gave the okay.

When we have a plan and budget, we will talk more with the school building leaders.

Budget

- Town would like level funded budget and 5% less
- Because Charter funds are going down, we are going to see a 5% cut no matter what.
- We have reserves that offer us some latitude.
- Stay the course for first six months of fiscal year 22 and then be back to "normal" the remaining 6 months.
- Salaries were discussed and budgeted with estimates for the entire year.
- Although we may not get it, bringing up the fact that we have increased media coverage, sets the ground work for increased funding from the town in the future.
- We average about 50 meetings covered by HCTV per month.
- Brittany explained that she was conservative when creating the budget, and that the studio really needs everything in there.
- Rob pointed out that we are not putting in the switcher this year, but that is a service now we can't provide. We are scaling back, but our scaling back effects our ability to help the town through the crisis of communication during the pandemic. Our communication services have never been more essential to the town. Scaling back jeopardizes our ability to fully cover meetings at the level we are currently providing.
- The school has been very supportive. We have in the past had discussions with Linda to increase FY22 school funding to \$25K.
- Work more on the budget draft in the next week or so, to be voted upon and submitted by Dec. 1.
- We will meet again on November 24 at 5:00 to specifically review and vote on the budget.

The town is asking town committee members if they are willing to create gmail addresses (first name, last initial 01451) so that the town can easily reach us individually. We collectively are not very interested in the idea. We are willing to be flexible, but for now we'd like to table the idea.
