Mooring/Raft Anchoring System

Summary description of the project:

Four Mooring buoys broke in the last 2 years due to improper attachment or the helical anchor being pulled out of the ground. A supplemental anchoring system is needed before an expensive boat is damaged. In addition, we leave the mooring balls on during the winter because it is extremely hard to find the anchors. This may contribute to the anchor pull out when the ice flows. This project would add mushroom anchors of helical extensions to 20 moorings, 3 beach rafts and 2 swimming area corner buoys. An anchor retrieval system will be developed to make it easier to locate the anchors in the spring & to prevent ice flow impacts. A mooring professional will be hired to determine the proper solution and to do the work. How will this project benefit the community?

Improved moorings for all town boaters and easier deployment of the beach raft and ropes by the lifeguards. Safety improvement to prevent damage to lottery winning boats. Reduced volunteer labor to install and repair the town moorings and beach equipment anchors each year.

Do you have any other funds available?

The town beach expense budget has \$700 each year to repair/service the docks and moorings. There is not enough to make a major improvement like this. This estimate is based on buying 25 mooring anchors @ \$675 each, anchor shackles/chain/buoy hardware for \$1000, an anchoring retrieval system @ \$2k and a contract for a mooring professional for \$10k.
