**Set four footings on the slope outside the wall of the Children's Room Patio.** Schematics and Photos/Attached

- remove, save and transplant shrubs as needed
- excavation of four 5'x5'x5' areas
- forms for footings and metal rebar cages + installation of those in place
- pour +/- 5 yds of 4000 psi concrete
- backfill/clean up and dispose of debris + hand seed

This project will require four 6" schedule 40 steel poles will be used to anchor the sails (2 outer poles that are 96" high and 2 inner poles that are 144" high). Poles will be electrostatically primed and painted black for easy maintenance or another color determined by the customer. Poles will be capped with 2 round plates at the top for a finished look.

Four custom brackets will be used to anchor on brick walls at approximate elevations of (left to right): 144", 168", 108", and 144". The brackets will be painted brown to blend in or another color determined by the customer.

3-piece shade sail. A system will be installed that will consist of:

Left: 3-point shade sail: 24' x 24' x 30'

Middle: 4-point shade sail: 24' x 30' x 27' x 30'

Right: 3-point sail: 20' x 24' x 30'

Colors of the shade sails to be determined (2 sails of one color with one contrasting color sail)
