DESCRIPTION OF WORK PROPOSED: (You may attach additional pages to describe your proposed work)

We plan an outdoor pavilion approximately 30 x 40 feet, with a shed-style roof. The floor is gray pavers, in a tone and pattern similar to the granite in the wall along Mass. Ave. and in the main library building. We chose metal posts because fewer were required for support, as compared to wooden posts. They are a dark bronze in color. The metal roof will be slate gray, similar in color to the library's slate roof. The ceiling will be tongue-and-groove wood.

Wooden slat siding on the back and part of the west side is for wind protection. A storage closet at the back will hold tables and chairs, as well as any equipment guest performers need to put there. The sections of the back slat wall not covered by the storage closet will be built as barn-door sliders that can be opened when wind protection is not needed.

The pavilion will have electricity and internet connectivity for programs by the library staff and special guest programs.

An ADA-compliant walkway will connect the library parking lot and the pavilion. Landscaping (not shown) will guide pedestrian access and keep people away from snow-slide areas at the back of the building.

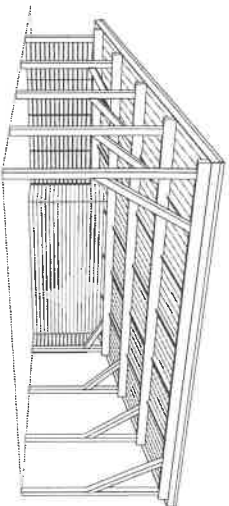

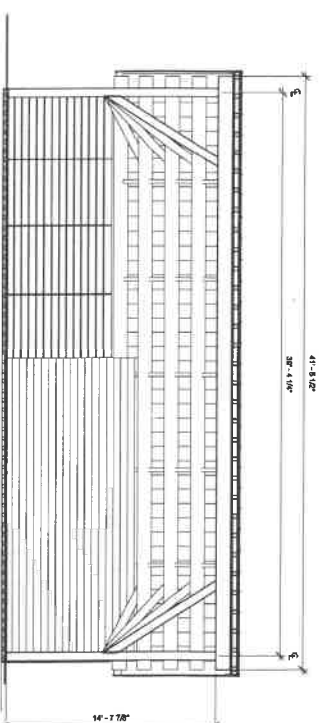

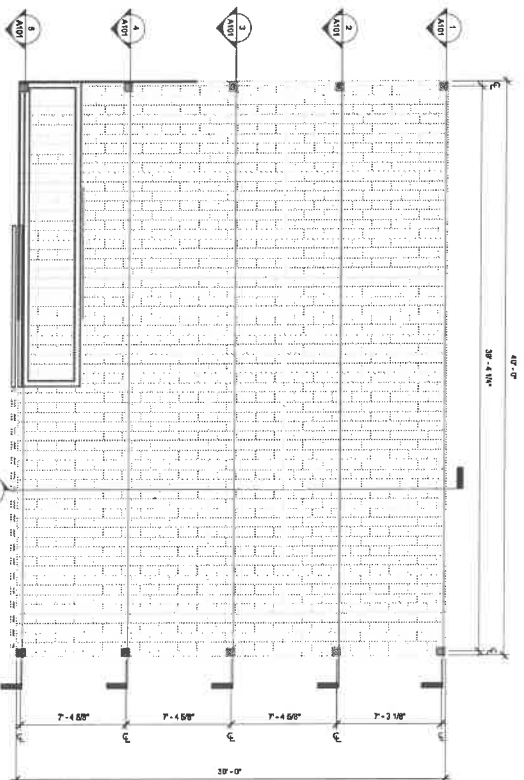

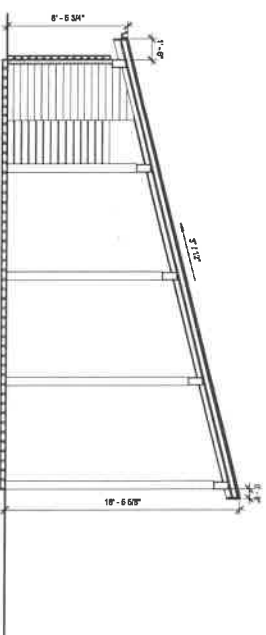
2 FRONT RIGHT VIEW



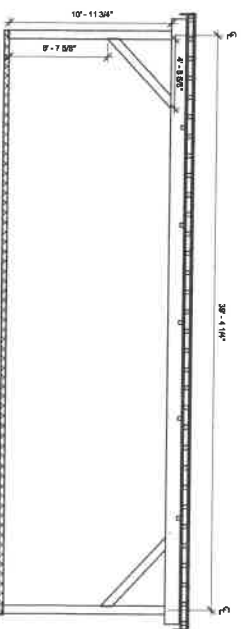
3 ELEVATION AT FRONT STRUCTURE

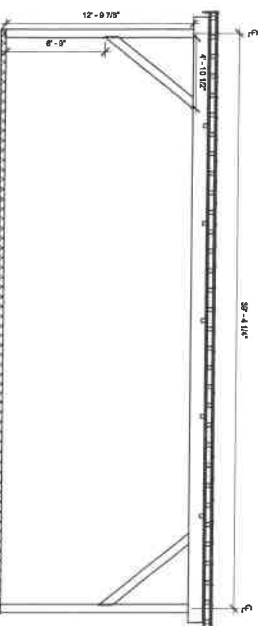
1 GROUND PLAN W DIMS

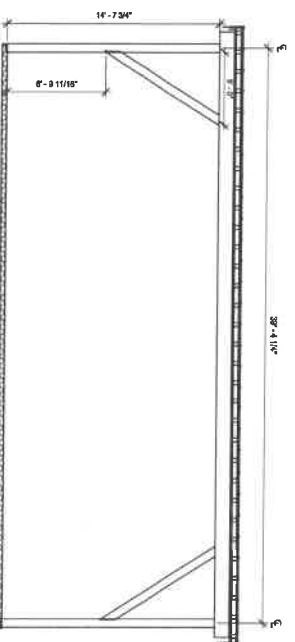
4 SECTION ANGLED ROOF

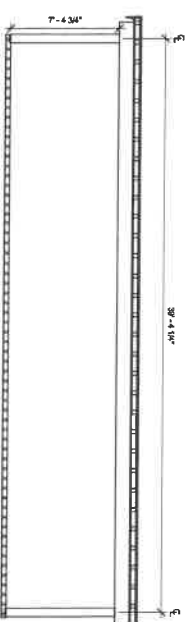
3 COLUMN ROW 3

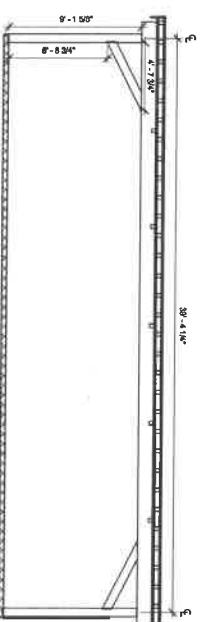
