Park and Rec initially submitted an application to finish repairing the wall between the Bromfield driveway and the crosswalk at HES at a request of \$80,000. CPC would like HHC to take over the project. Pam will meet with Joe Schmidt who was on Park and Rec during the original application to repair the wall, to discuss the project. She will also be in contact with Ron Ostberg, former architect commissioner, who advised Park and Rec during the original application. CPC requested that she be the Project Manager until the completion of this phase of the project. Since the issue of sidewalks along Mass Avenue is yet to be determined, no action will be taken on the remaining part of the wall.
