## Potential Actions / Discussion:

- 1. Review elm fungicide injection past and present plan (June injection estimate is \$3,318).
- 2. Discuss logistics of tree grant planting:
  - a. When to plant (school and DPW constraints, nursery inventory, volunteer availability...?)
  - b. Have hand dug all 6 island holes to verify that no wires are in holes
  - c. Need to get edge of stone wall cleared to plant 3 sugar maples at edge of Bromfield parking lot (locusts were cut and hope DPW can clear out trunks and brambles prior to planting along all of wall).
  - d. Park & Rec has approved Ryan Land (will finalize location later), Library and Bromfield Trustee were emailed—need feedback. Will also call 2 neighbors to Ryan Field (hope they can help water)
  - e. Grant budget and accounting will be coordinated with specific charge numbers.
  - f. Review two alternatives for planting schedule (assume 3 teams of 3 people for each of the three areas.
- 3. Tom Garfield is good to go for tree watering this season—Bill will order more bags when grant planting date is determined.
- 4. Newsletter for Harvard Tree Fund to be printed by early April.
- 5. Discuss funding needs vs budget increase for June 2018 –June 2019 from Forestry Budget (include priority Elm tree pruning, injections, lime, potentially above grant matching funds....)
