

War Memorial Meeting

Present: Jon Schoenberg, Pat Jennings, Steve Cronin, and John Lee.

Jon handed out a list of participants of the WWI ceremony that need letters of thanks.

Pat presented a bill for \$87.58 for presentation materials for the WWI ceremony. Jon will submit it for payment.

Steve reported that the veteran's agent has a 1963 list of those that served in WWII. It matches closely a Harvard Historical Society list. HHS list has 138 that served, veteran's agent has 168 names from the original plaque. The veteran's agent also has a list of 49 that served in Korea, 80 from Vietnam, and 42 from Desert Storm.

Steve reported how Shirley and Ayer uses a form that they use. Individuals need to fill it out as a record of their service. Shirley stopped updating their list. Steve will get a copy of Ayer's application form.

There was a proposal to print our current list and publish it with a request for additional names.

Pat reported Mary Zoll's recommendations for the WWII memorial. Small benches are not recommended. And printing of names either in a string or in a list takes up the same amount of space.
