## TOWN CENTER WASTEWATER POLICY COMMITTEE

Approved 4/28/2009

Mission: The Town Center Wastewater Policy Committee (TCWPC) shall be

responsible for all activity related to the development of policies and procedures that will be used to guide the activities of the Harvard Wastewater Management District Commission in advance of the

appointment of the Commissioners.

Membership: The Town Center Wastewater Policy Committee will be comprised of seven

(7) voting members consisting of four (4) members who are owners of real property located within the Town Center Sewer District and three (3) members who are owners of real property outside the district. All voting

members shall be registered voters of the Town of Harvard. All

appointments shall be made by the Board of Selectmen.

Term of Appointment: This will be an ad hoc committee which will commence their activities

when appointed by the Board of Selectmen and will end when the Harvard Wastewater Management District Commission policies have been approved

by the Selectmen.

Selection Process: Consideration of requests for membership shall be acted upon at the first

Selectmen's meeting following the May 5, 2009 election with appointments

made in accordance with the Selectmen's appointment process.

Responsibility: The TCWPC shall develop policies and procedures to guide the activity of

the Sewer Commissioners. These policies and procedures will be subject to approval by the Board of Selectmen and shall be binding upon the Harvard

Wastewater Management District Commission.

Reporting: The TCWPC shall make regular reports to the Board of Selectmen and shall

properly post their meetings and maintain meeting minutes in accordance

with the provisions of the Open Meeting Law
